# **Finding Work in France**

### How to get authorization to work in France (in steps)

- 1. You must receive a job offer from an organization in France where the employer must send you a draft of contract for the job.
- 2. The French employer then sends an application to the Office des Migrations Internationales. The employment must be approved by the French Ministry of Labor, who then sends their approval to a French Consulate near you.
- 3. If approved you must make an appointment for a free medical exam on the basis of the results you will be issued a visa. NOTE: You must obtain a long stay visa as a worker before entering France.
- 4. Eight days after arrival you must go to the nearest police station and present them with your passport and medical certificate, where on approval the police station will issue you a residency permit.
